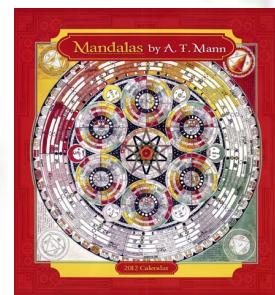
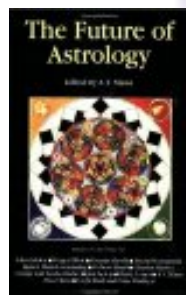
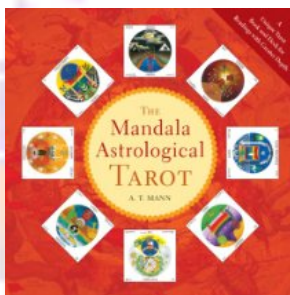
Mandala Astrological Tarot

Tad Mann designed and painted a square tarot deck with circular mandala images which integrates Egyptian, Gnostic, Medieval, and archetypal imagery with astrological structure. The major arcana cards are scenes of the stages of the process of integration into which the initiate places her/himself. You are aided by guided meditations and explanations of the cards, their symbolism and the ways in which they may be used. The interaction between astrology and tarot allows beginners with a basic knowledge of astrology to understand and do tarot readings.

There are many tarot sets on the market but none like this! The first thing you'll notice about this unique book-and-card set is the deck's square shape, which allows each card to be positioned facing not just two, but all four cardinal points of the compass, providing readings of great depth and accuracy. The original design eliminates the conventional human figures of the tarot, replacing them with mandala images that aid meditation. What's more, the 22 major arcana signs are divided into three groups corresponding to the signs of the zodiac, the elements, and the planets. This spiritually aware approach to the tarot provides a remarkable new set of tools for understanding the forces that shape our lives.



Tad has served on the NCGR Board, and was designer and editor of the new NCGR Research Journal. Currently, he is a member of the organizing board of UAC2012, due to be held in New Orleans next May. In connection with UAC, Tad has been nominated for a Regulus Award, astrology's highest honor. He'll soon begin directing a two year research experiment and 90-minute documentary in collaboration with the Dalai Lama's foundation to explore meditation and neuroscience and The Art and Science of Happiness. The project will also comprise two TV programs.
